### **OBSERVE**

- How is this similar to us when we try to live life on our own?

#### **Read 1 Kings 3:5-9**

- How is Solomon feeling at this point? Have you ever felt this way in life? When and for what reason?
- What specifically does Solomon ask for? For what purposes?

## **Read 1 Kings 3:10-15**

- What is God's response? What does this tell us about God's character? How do you see "good news" in this passage?

1. What does this text say is true about God?
2. What does this text say is true about us?
3. What does this text say (or imply) should be done in response to these truths?
4. What is one specific thing you could do (or change) this week in obedience to what this text says?
